Environmental programs on track

Community and environment groups have joined forces with the Fiona Stanley Hospital project team and environmental specialists to carry out a range of activities on the Murdoch site.

Work has already included seed collection, reptile and Quenda relocation, the translocation of grass trees, zamias and orchids, and timber salvage.

The work is part of the project's \$2.3 million investment in environmental initiatives, which also includes the protection and/or rehabilitation of approximately 100 hectares of land in local and Wheatbelt areas and \$575,000 for community grants and research programs. [... read more](#)
