



## Site office completion only weeks away



The Fiona Stanley Hospital on-site office building is nearing completion. It will house 120 people from the Fiona Stanley Hospital and Brookfield Multiplex teams working on the project. The teams are expected to move to the site in July. Some members of the project team will continue to operate from the existing offices in Mount Pleasant.

The building will be the construction office until 2013, when it will be demolished to make way for landscaping and parking.

## New services for Fiona Stanley Hospital

Obstetric and neonatal services will be included in the services provided when the Fiona Stanley Hospital opens its doors in 2014.

Fiona Stanley Hospital Executive Director Brad Sebbes said the hospital will include a 30-bed obstetric unit and an 18-cot neonatal unit, along with an eight-bed mother and baby facility within the mental health unit.

“With WA’s increasing birth rate the new services will enable more women from the southern suburbs to deliver their children closer to home,” Mr Sebbes said.

“The service will reduce pressure on King Edward Memorial Hospital and provide more complex levels of care in the south. There will also be a wide range of midwifery-led, community-based services available.”

Mr Sebbes said the design team is now working to incorporate these areas into the hospital’s planning and continuing to consult with clinicians, staff and other stakeholders.

In other news, in its 2009 budget, the Federal Government announced it would contribute \$255.7million for a new State Rehabilitation Centre on the Fiona Stanley Hospital site. It is hoped the new facility will be completed in 2014. [... read more](#)
