

Providing first-class education and training opportunities

Education and training play a vital role in delivering a high standard of health care in Western Australia. When it opens in 2014, the Fiona Stanley Hospital will be Western Australia's premier teaching hospital. Its Education and Training Centre will provide a progressive and multidisciplinary approach to educating students in all health disciplines and facilitate ongoing education for hospital staff and the wider South Metropolitan Area Health Service.

The Education and Training Centre will include:

- one major tiered lecture theatre;
- two small tiered lecture theatres;
- a range of seminar and meeting rooms;
- a clinical skills training centre and a medical emergency training/simulation centre;
- a Management of Aggression Training room;
- a clinical library;
- a computer learning centre;
- a medical illustrations / audio visual / telehealth unit; and
- the Fiona Stanley Hospital Education Unit (including post-graduate medical education, nursing and corporate education, and allied health education services).

A variety of **meeting and tutorial venues** will accommodate lectures, seminars, presentations and meetings for different group sizes. All rooms will be capable of audio-visual and teleconferencing activities.

The **clinical skills and simulation centre** will accommodate a comprehensive range of clinical skills training such as safe handling, advanced life support, aggression training, communication and behavioural skills. The centre will also accommodate emergency training simulation activities and techniques that are important to demonstrate competence at all levels of staff and health disciplines.

The **clinical library** will have computers, study desks, internet access, database access and inter-library loans

for staff and students. Skilled library staff will be available to assist with reference queries, internet and database searches. Staff and students will have access to library services – including journal holdings, the library catalogue, online books, journals and databases – from any desktop in the hospital.

The **computer learning centre** will support the training activities for the new software and computer programs that will be integrated into the Fiona Stanley Hospital system.

The **medical illustrations unit** and **telehealth department** will provide a variety of services including:

- clinical photography and video production;
- management and delivery of health-related services and information at a distance, including video conferencing; and
- support for audiovisual activities.

Telehealth facilities will be available to deliver a host of health-related information and healthcare services to those living and working in regional and remote areas, benefiting patients and healthcare workers alike. These facilities will not only assist in treating patients, but can also be used to educate healthcare staff and promote knowledge-sharing.

The Education and Training Centre will also accommodate **Education Units** for nursing and corporate education, post-graduate medical education and allied health education.

The Education and Training Centre will also provide, manage and organise all Fiona Stanley Hospital **workforce training and development**.
